

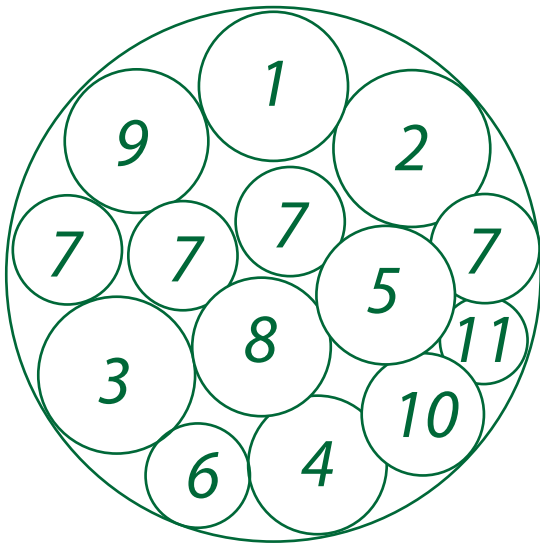

How-to basics:

1. Fill about 2/3 of the way with potting soil.
2. Add an organic fertilizer and mix with the soil.
3. Gently remove plants from pots and loosen up the roots and add them to the container.
4. Fill in the spaces between plants with soil; gently packing as you go.
5. Water thoroughly - until water comes out the bottom - and check for any gaps created as the soil settles.
6. Enjoy!

Maintenance + Care:

Remove old flowers to encourage new ones. As the weather gets colder, the annuals will die, leaving room for the perennials to grow. Feed the plants in the spring with organic fertilizer and add more annuals if there's room.



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Substitutions: Occasionally we are out of specific plants.
